

Among them: One new neon sign in rainbow colors will be produced as the title of the exhibition "Breathe Walk Die;" Horizon wall paintings fully cover the walls of the museum from the first to the fifth floor, each floor showing three graduation of colors and the ensemble developing the full color spectrum of the rainbow; a pair of clown shoes, part of a group of seven shoes each representing a day of the week; and a performance of 40 clowns existing in the gallery spaces, titled "Vocabulary of Solitude."
